oral histories women telling their
stories in front of the camera -
tremendous response - small centers -
unusual means of distribution - dearth
of Latin American f's voices - "we came
much later than all of you"

film festivals - "I haven't been around
all female film-makers in a long
time." - very different & exciting
good to have gay & lesbian festivals that
take away from feminist film
discussions - sometimes gotten a
little bit lost
- 4260 Alex - how do you historicize the cast
of these festivals
- 4270 Sue - women make "good enough" films -
don't need → include in regular
film festivals
- 4280 Tilly - shift from women's films and
went on to gay film festivals →
problems - "if just two girls
fucking" - not lesbian gay film
festivals programmed by men!
miss dialogue between heterosexual
and homosexual women
- 4299 Alex - something that's missing →
what do we want to retrieve

- 4369 woman in black, hair tied back, a bit older → video is really different from film - not question of distribution - a lot of different uses - hard to capture products of that time - women's centers that have video and use it in a different way → activities as organizing and as products that can be distributed
- 4455 Sara - development of parallel audiences - no crossing over - lesbian subjects are not normalized
- 4478 Alfragail - films feature identity - narrow focused audience - distribution targeting - good side - getting the stuff out
- 4510 Alice - demographics
- 4518 Greta - cross - cues still very important - baby step - beginning white & next to Sara w/ short black hair - "Good Machine" - initial audience cue known but complicated strategies of distribution
- 4534 Alex - difficulty about history → multiple layers - Hollywood vs. independence vs. films about process → inter-relationships interesting can you put it all together? → how can you respect all these layers
- 4575 Greta - don't complete all layers into one story - "lure of origins" → doesn't quite work → we don't connect we scared of the overlap - ex. maya deren
